# FLORIDA STATE APPROVALS

Effective November 1, 2004, IKO has achieved Product Approval for its Cambridge 30/30 AR laminated shingles, and its Gentry series of asphalt shingles in the State of Florida. The specific application/approval file number is **FL 3492**. This approval has been updated to comply with the 2007 Code requirements.

The subject shingles conform to the requirements of ASTM's D 3462 product standard for glass fiber reinforced asphalt shingles, as well as ASTM's D 3161 test method for wind resistance, modified to 110 mph. IKO uses the prestigious Factory Mutual (FM) test agency as its independent certification authority. All bundles of IKO shingles bear the FM stamp.

It should be noted that the approval is limited to applications outside of Florida's high velocity hurricane zones (HVHZ), and as such, IKO shingles do not have approval for use in Broward or Miami-Dade counties (currently defined as HVHZ by the Florida Building Code).

All IKO glass fiber shingles are constructed on one of the industry's heaviest and strongest glass mat reinforcements, which give the shingles exceptional tear resistance values. As well, IKO uses an SBS-modified shingle sealant for superior shingle bond strength on all glass fiber shingle products. Each of IKO's shingle manufacturing facilities produces, and therefore controls, the shingle sealant on-site.
