The IKO Approved Applicator Program (IAAP) offers independent roofing contractors access to benefits and services designed by IKO Commercial to help build a standard of excellence in commercial roofing. Together, IKO and the approved applicators will establish a level of quality in roofing that provides general contractors, building owners, and specifiers with the highest confidence in the roofing system applications warrantied by IKO. The benefits and services available through your membership in the IAAP include:

- Eligibility to install IKO Innovi™ Roofing Systems eligible for the IKO Diamond Shield Limited Warranty, providing complete coverage of materials, labor, workmanship and the Membrane Material Limited Warranty providing coverage for materials only.
- Expert training for your roofing crews in the application of IKO Innovi Roofing Systems.
- Dedicated technical support from an IKO Commercial Field Services Technician, including inspections for Diamond Shield Limited Warranties.
- Shop-fabricated edge metal included in warranty at no additional charge.
- Listing in the online IKO Approved Applicator finder tool.
- Eligible to participate in courses at the IKO Experience Center in Hagerstown, MD.
- Applicators with dedicated Service Departments may be eligible to perform warranty repairs on other projects.

#### **IKO COMMERCIAL APPLICATOR TRAINING**

IKO offers applicator training in formats designed to fit your experience, time, and project-specific needs:

- 2-hour training sessions are intended only for seasoned single-ply applicators
  holding current licenses from other major single-ply manufacturers. Once their
  IAAP Application is approved, these applicators will be welcomed into the IKO
  Approved Applicator Program at the conclusion of their training session.
- 4-hour training sessions are intended for applicators that have had only
  occasional experience installing single-ply. This training session is required
  for full entry into the IKO Approved Applicator Program, along with IKO Technical
  Services inspection and approval of at least two (2) completed single-ply projects.
- **8-hour** training sessions are intended for beginner single-ply applicators. This training session is required for entry into the IKO Approved Applicator Program, along with IKO Technical Services inspection and approval of at least two (2) completed single-ply projects.
- Courses can be tailored to fit project-specific needs, through use of our
   IKO Commercial Applicator Pre-Training Checklist. If your crew needs a refresher
   on spray-applied adhesives, or induction weld single-ply application, or any other
   specific point of roofing application, you can indicate your wishes on our checklist,
   and receive specific training.

## TO BECOME AN IKO APPROVED APPLICATOR:

- 1. Complete and submit the IAAP U.S. Application.
- 2. Provide project references; two completed projects, two current projects.
- 3. Complete and submit an IKO Credit Application (for purchase of warranties, and of materials if requested).
- Install a minimum total 100 squares per year of IKO
   Commercial Roofing Systems that receive an IKO Diamond Shield Limited Warranty.
- 5. Successfully complete any required IKO Commercial Applicator Training.
- 6. Maintain liability insurance of at least \$1 million aggregate.
- 7. Maintain bonding capacity of at least \$1 million.
- 8. Hold membership in NRCA or other professional trade association.
