LEED v4 Building Design and Construction (BD+C) Credit Contribution – IKO ArmourCoolTM Products

Directly Applicable Credits

1. Sustainable Sites: Heat Island Reduction (possible LEED points: 2, except Healthcare: 1 point)

Applicable to: LEEDv4 programs:

New Construction (NC), Core and Shell (CS), Schools, Retail, Data Centers, Warehouses and Distribution centers, Hospitality, Healthcare

The following IKO products have an initial Solar Reflective Index (SRI) of 82, which meets the "High-Reflectance Roof" requirement for low-sloped roofing (less than or equal to 2-in-12) and can contribute towards Option 1 of the Heat Island Reduction Credit.

Guidance to Designers/Consultants:

This heat island reduction credit is achieved from a combination of non-roof, high-reflectance (roof) and vegetative roof measures. Using any of the above products listed above will contribute to credit achievement.

2. Building Product Disclosure and Optimization (BPDO)- Environmental Product Declarations (EPD) (possible points: 1-2, where EPD's contribute 1 point)

Applicable to: LEEDv4 programs:

New Construction (NC), Core and Shell (CS), Schools, Retail, Data Centers, Warehouses and Distribution Centers, Hospitality, Healthcare
