A surface coating of IKO modified asphalt also provides superior weather-resistance. On the roof, their dimensional thickness helps create the look of natural stone. In your hands, their weight will convince you that we've built them to last. They're constructed of two fiberglass mats laminated together. The lower ("shim") is coated with oxidized asphalt; the upper ("lid" or "cap") is saturated with our special IKO modified asphalt.
